## Spiritual Habits, Practices, and Growth

By the time you read this column, we'll be well on our way into this new year. As I consider how this year will be different from those past, particularly with regard to my spiritual life and growth, I'm drawn to a process in which we in Enriching Disciples have been invited to engage. Each of us has been invited to develop spiritual habits that will be formative in our spiritual growth. Because they have been helpful to many of us in our group, I thought I would share them with you and invite you to develop these habits as well. We call them spiritual practices.

At the outset, I want to be very clear that you are the one who decides which spiritual practices will be helpful and meaningful to you and how often you will engage in these practices. This should in no way be considered prescriptive. You will be helped, though, by finding some means of accountability.

- I encourage you to **practice spiritual reading**. This could be a book of the Bible or it could be a Christian classic or contemporary book on the spiritual life. Grow in your understanding of God's Word and grow in your understanding of the myriad ways in which faith transforms life or addresses life issues.
- You may find **spiritual mentoring** helpful. A good spiritual mentor will rarely direct you or tell you what to do; instead she or he will be skilled in asking probing, insightful questions. Most importantly, she or he will be able to help you pay attention to the ways in which God is working in your life.
- A practice that is very difficult for many of us but, at the same time so necessary, is that of **silence and solitude**. We live in a world filled with noise, so much so that many of us can hardly stand the sound of silence. If our lives are so crowded by noise, it will be difficult to hear that still, small voice of the Holy Spirit. Make time periodically to be alone, to listen, to open yourself to God's leading.

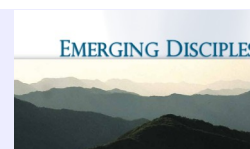

- Another practice that is equally difficult is that of **Sabbath**. Sabbath simply involves rest, letting go of the busyness that consumes our lives. It's intentionally "letting go" of everything that we think is so vital and important to our personal success and allowing God to refresh and replenish us.
- Finally, **practice taking care of yourself**. Focus with intentionality on good sleep habits. Watch not only how much you eat but also what you eat. Find ways to exercise that will rejuvenate you.

In Genesis we read that it was when God breathed the breath of life into the human that God had created that the human became a living being. As you develop these spiritual practices, allow God to breathe into you the breath of new life. You might discover how life-giving that breath is!

In order to continue our goals of reaching, rooting, and releasing for Christ we need your involvement. Thank you for all the gifts of your time, talents, and resources. Last year because of your gifts to our Capital Campaign we were able to pay to our principal an additional \$116,094. That enabled us to reamortize our loan and reduce our monthly payment from \$10,902 to \$9,735. What a blessing!

New Hope Preschool is currently registering children for the 2012-13 school year. During the early enrollment period for current preschool and church families, we enrolled 133 children; last year at this time we had 97 children enrolled. We started accepting enrollments from new families on January 23.



In January we received our Two Star Step Up To Quality money incentive. What is a Step Up To Quality Program (SUTQ)? In order to be a SUTQ Program we have to meet certain criteria: lower student to teacher ratios, higher teacher qualifications, the use of an approved curriculum, documentation of the program as well as documentation of each child's progress. It is a lot of extra work for the preschool, but the benefits to the program are wonderful. We are the only Powell preschool program to achieve this goal.

### Adult Mission Trip

On a hot Sunday afternoon in July 2011, **Donna Gleditsch, Ken & Kathy Hammond, Gretchen Henoeh, Ed & Terri Klinker, Johnny & Nancy Wagoner,** and **Jim & Marla Underwood** left the church parking lot with Jackson County Ministries in Annville, Kentucky as the destination for this adult mission trip. It was the first time a New Hope group had volunteered as a work team for this Reformed Church in America ministry. The skills of the group varied, but we knew **Jake Moss**, Executive Director and **Frank VanHoeve**, Project Coordinator would keep us busy.

Donna, a certified aquatic instructor, was asked to help at the community swimming pool when one of the life guards became ill. She taught swim lessons, served as a life guard, and provided advanced training of the other pool staff. The rest of the group drove each day to Gloria's house. No doubt Gloria was nervous as nine people invaded her home to work on the assigned projects! By the end of the first day, the ice was broken. Projects included the replacement of ten windows, two doors, and window blinds; exterior and interior painting; and diagnosing the reason for her sagging kitchen floor and fixing it. Half of us were either unskilled or semi-skilled regarding construction projects, but without a doubt God's hand guided us, and we all contributed in the completion of the work plan. Gloria now has windows that open to take advantage of the lovely summer breezes that blow up on the hill where her home sits and windows that will keep out cold winter drafts. Her windows had been inoperable for seven years. Paint freshened up the outside and inside of her home. After replacing a support beam under the kitchen floor, the sagging and safety of her kitchen was improved. Gloria was also pleased with her new linoleum floor.

The mission trip provided the opportunity for us to bless another person through some "sweat equity." In return we were blessed. There was joy in helping Gloria and getting to know those from New Hope better. Thanks to **Terri Klinker** who organized the trip, those who went on the trip and all of the New Hope congregation who supported the trip with donations. Your donations enabled us to purchase tools and equipment that we in turn donated to Jackson County Ministries.

Another mission trip is being planned for October 2012. Give God a chance to lead you by opening your heart and listening for His gentle call. All you really need is a desire to work for Him and to be open to new experiences! Watch for information within the next several months as details become available. 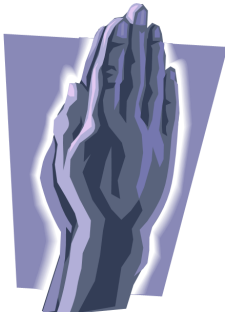
